Biographical/Historical Sketch

The Nashville Banner newspaper began publication on Apr. 10, 1876 and ceased publication Feb. 20, 1998.

Scope and Contents of the Collection

The Nashville Banner Reporter Reference Files, Tennessee Series has information about statewide topics, places, organizations, and county government outside of Davidson County that received news coverage in the Nashville Banner newspaper. Materials date from the 1930s to the 1990s. Formats include press releases, brochures, booklets, reports, texts of legislative bills, clippings and magazine articles, wire service stories, and more. Quantity of materials is usually less than ten items for each topic. Some items are photocopies.

All the materials in this collection were originally housed in the Banner Clippings Files, but were removed by library staff for preservation purposes. Thus, although the Banner Reporter Reference Files is a separate collection, due to its size, it nevertheless bears a very close relationship and indeed should be viewed as an extension of the Banner Clippings Files. Information in both instances was compiled and used by reporters at the Nashville Banner as references when writing about significant events of the time. Researchers are advised that due to its being a much more comprehensive resource, the Banner Clippings Files will likely be a more useful and productive source of information than the isolated items to be found in the Banner Reporter Reference Files. Some items of special note include various materials about state government, departments, and specific legislative bills; and information on the 1996 Olympics whitewater canoe/kayak slalom event at the Ocoee Whitewater Center on the Ocoee River in the Cherokee National Forest.

Additional materials include: historical information compiled around 1966 on the 101st Airborne Division of Fort Campbell including brigade histories, as well as considerable information about the Military Air Transport Service (MATS) and training exercises around 1962 called "Big Slam/Puerto Pines." Other materials document Sewart Air Force Base, the 18th Air Force, and the 314th Troop Carrier Wing. Significant quantities of materials concern: the legal case of the merger of the L&N and N.C. & St.L. Railroads; various aspects of the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA); and the University of the South at Sewanee, including information about segregation and race relations in the late 1950s and early 1960s.

Additional materials of interest to individuals researching Tennessee's Civil Rights history include: wire service stories about the desegregation of Clinton High School in Anderson County; a blank membership form for the White Citizen's Council; items relating to organizations such as the National Association for the Advancement of White People, and the Tennessee Federation for Constitutional Government, which opposed desegregation; and a legal complaint filed in the Baker v. Carr reapportionment case.
